From the Web: Water and Wellness

Bio-sand filters, which cost as little as US\$60, reduce waterborne pathogens by more than 90 percent. With no moving parts or required maintenance, all the user has to do is pour water in. Layers of sand and gravel trap parasites, and beneficial bacteria growing on the sand kill micro-organisms.

Rotary club members have helped install 19,000 bio-sand filters in the Dominican Republic through the Rotarian-led Children's Safe Water Alliance, reaching an estimated 100,000 people in 300 communities. For seven years, more than 200 clubs in 18 districts in Canada, the Dominican Republic, the United States, and other Caribbean countries have supported the effort, as has The Rotary Foundation, with 30 Matching Grants.
